Frequently Asked Questions

1. What happens if I can't raise the requested \$100?

It is always good to have a goal, but we will of course accept as much as you can raise through your best efforts!

2. How do we make sure the money reaches Sunrise?

We request that your teacher or SCAI representative deposit the cash into the following account along with that of your classmates, along with the school name and class as the deposit reference.

3. Can the program be run in schools outside of Australia?

Yes, however SCAI will need to approve the person acting as the SCAI representative, and as SCAI is only a Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) in Australia, we are unable to issue tax deductible receipts to overseas donors.

4. What if I can't complete the challenge during the specified week because I will be away or fall sick or something that prevents me from completing it? Can I do it earlier or later?

Yes, if your teacher, parents and the SCAI representative are happy to co-ordinate for you to do it another week that is ok. But it should be within 2 weeks either side of the scheduled date.

5. When does the money I have raised need to be given to my teacher?

We request you give your teacher the money within 2 weeks of completion of the challenge. This date will be based on the challenge dates written on your form, that your teacher and parents need to sign.
